NOTES:

The nomination proposal must include a precise description of the nominated Area's location, boundaries, and size, along with an associated digital shapefile location map, employing the National Geocentric Reference Frame (MAGNA – SIRGAS) as Colombia's official datum, with the singular origin as designated by the Agustín Codazzi Geographic Institute – IGAC pursuant to the Resolution. Additionally, one must:

- a. Identify within the Nominated Area any segment where fishing activity is present, as reported by the National Aquaculture and Fisheries Authority or its equivalent, upon the nominating Participant's request.
- b. Excluding conservation sites on the continental shelf, important biodiversity areas and environmental conservation areas from the Nominated Area. For these purposes, the nominating Participant must request the corresponding information from the Ministry of Environment and Sustainable Development and other authorities.
- c. Excluding areas limited by national security or sovereignty issues from the Nominated Area, according to information sent by DIMAR, upon request of the nominating Participant.
- d. Indicating the ecosystems within the Nominated Area, according to the information provided by the Ministry of Environment and Sustainable Development, and other competent environmental authorities, upon request of the nominating Participant.
- e. Identifying if there are archaeological areas within the Nominated Area, according to the information sent by the Colombian Institute of Anthropology and History (ICANH), or whoever acts in its stead.
- f. Demonstrating that the Nominated Area is not located at a distance of less than 500 meters from submarine cables, according to the information provided by DIMAR, upon request of the nominating Participant.
