## DATA SPECIFICATIONS AND BASES OF SPECIFIC CONDITIONS

The administrator will prepare the document of data specifications and bases of specific conditions, which must be published without the prior objection of the DIMAR and the Ministry of Mines and Energy.

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## ENABLING

Those who intend to participate in the assignment process, must provide compliance with the established requirements.

Technical, financial and legal qualification.

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## AREA NOMINATION

The proponent who has exceeded the qualification stage may propose new areas for the development of its project.

DIMAR will evaluate technically according to the criteria and will pronounce on the suitability.

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## SUBMISSION OF OFFERS

- 1 offer for each area nominated
- Description and location plan
- Installed capacity and density
- Date of commissioning
- Schedule and S curve
- Letter presenting the offer
- Guarantee of seriousness of the offer



## EVALUATION AND SELECTION

The proposals will be qualified with the defined criteria, and the maritime areas will be assigned to the offers with the highest score



## FORMALIZATION OF THE AWARD

Evaluation and selection of proposals through an act, and delivery by the successful bidders of a guarantee of compliance.


The result of the competitive process will be the Temporary Occupation Permit on the maritime areas



## FOLLOW UP


Dimar will follow up on the execution of activities during the validity of the Temporary Occupation Permit, as well as during the Validity of the Maritime Concussion



Characteristics that an area must meet to be declared suitable:



The nominated area may not exceed 270 km in extension and must be within the limits defined in Annex A.




Does not overlap with protected areas



Does not overlap with seagrass




Does not overlap with identified areas of national security or sovereignty



**APPENDIX A. Competitive Process Area.**  
**Resolution No. 40284 of 2022 of the Ministry of Mines and Energy and DIMAR.**

The outcome of the competitive process is the Temporary Occupation Permit for maritime areas.



It consists of an administrative act issued by DIMAR within 30 business days following the delivery of the compliance guarantee, whereby the winning proposer is granted exclusivity over a specific area for a period of eight (8) years, which may be extended based on certain grounds.




Development of activities related to measurement and collection of data and information to establish the viability of the project and, if viability exists, the necessary activities to obtain licenses and permits for the construction of the offshore wind energy generation project.



The request for maritime concession must be submitted at least 9 months before the expiration of the Temporary Occupation Permit


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**Administrative act issued by DIMAR, by which the use and enjoyment of a maritime public asset is granted to a specific person, in order to develop a project or activity**

The Awardee may request from DIMAR the granting of the concession for the development of the project, provided that: (i) they have complied with the terms and obligations of the Temporary Occupation Permit, and (ii) they present the documentation, permits, and licenses necessary for the construction of the project, in accordance with Decree 2106 of 2019.



The activities to be carried out under the Maritime Concession shall include those related to the **construction, operation, maintenance, and dismantling of the project**, as well as the activities necessary for the generation of electric power and connection to the National Transmission System, if required. The duration of the Concession is 30 years, which may be subject to different extensions totaling no more than 15 years
