Use the National Geocentric Reference Frame (MAGNA-SIRGAS) as the official Colombian datum and the unique origin set by the Agustín Codazzi Institute - IGAC as outlined in Resolution 370 of 2021.
 - 1.1. The extension of each proposed area must not exceed 270 KM².
2. The Offer must consider that, for building the Project, it must maintain a distance of at least one (1) nautical mile from other wind power projects.
3. Installed Capacity in MW: _____ (must be at least 200 MW).
4. MW Density per km² (MW/km²): _____ (must be at least 3 MW/km²).
5. Operational Date: _____ (must be within 10 years following the issue of the Administrative Act that grants the Temporary Occupancy Permit).

7. The necessary information to certify the experience described in section 9.6.2. Only certifications will be received, in the terms contained in these Terms and Conditions, not copies of contracts.
8. Consider Annex H. Definitions and items for accreditation of the Experience Criteria in the Offer.
9. In addition, the following documentation must be presented, which will not be binding if the Proponent is the successful Proponent.

- (i) Declare the power per turbine and the technology intended to be used (for example, fixed, floating, or other wind structure).
- (ii) Estimate the plant factor in terms of annual average.
- (iii) Indicate LCOE or levelized cost of energy (in \$USD/KWH) estimated for the project.
- (iv) Indicate the CAPEX – investment costs, and OPEX – operation costs (in \$USD/MW and \$USD/MW/year respectively) estimated for the Project.
