Example:

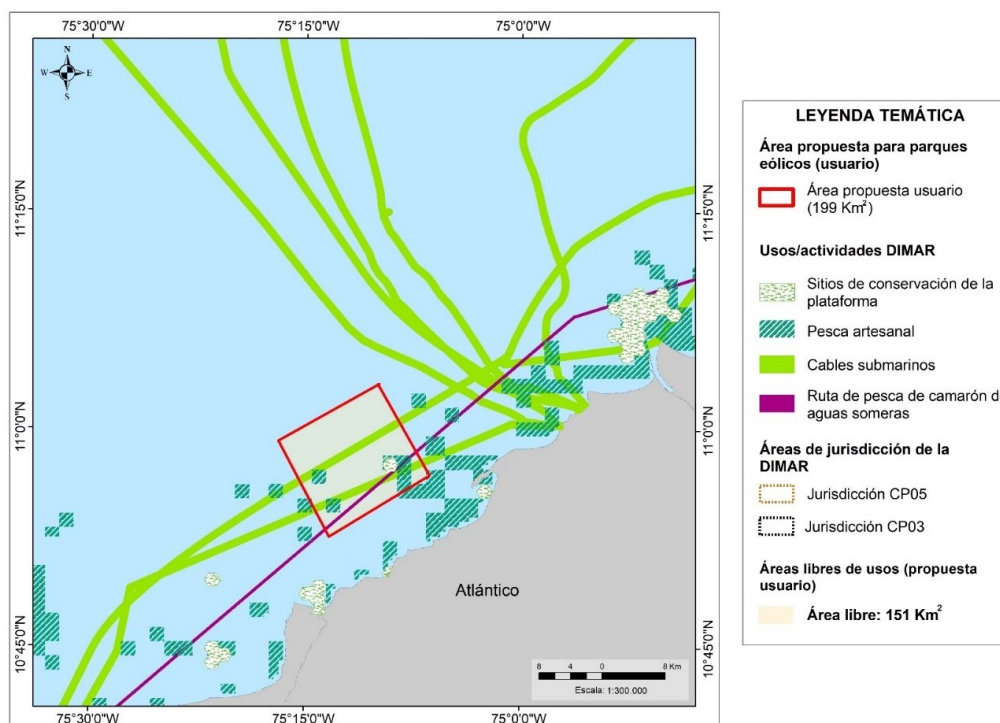


Figure 1. Identified uses/activities within the area of interest.

"The area proposed by the XXXX project overlaps with a total of XXX uses/activities (Figure 1 and Table 2) pertaining to submarine cables (already depicted with the protective buffer as per DIMAR Resolution 204 of 2012), artisanal fishing zones, platform conservation sites, and shallow water shrimp fishing routes. Among these uses, the proponent is not allowed to make an offer on zones with submarine cables and platform conservation sites."
