INSTRUCTIONS ACCESS TO INFORMATION AND REQUEST FOR DATA ROOM SESSIONS

The data and information of this Competitive Process are available for those interested in the pre-qualification, at no cost, for consultation or downloading, receiving technical assistance and support, of required, from specialized ANH or DIMAR staff, who will answer any doubts or concerns that may arise in the sessions of the so called "Data Room", after signing a confidentiality agreement.

The information available or supplied cannot be shared nor commercialized without prior authorization from the ANH.

The data and information in the Data Package for the FIRST COLOMBIAN OFFSHORE WIND ENERGY ROUND will be displayed for those interested in reviewing it, with the assistance and technical support of ANH, INVEMAR, and DIMAR specialists. These experts will resolve any queries or concerns during the sessions in the designated Data Room, following the signing of a confidentiality agreement. The information provided should not be shared or commercialized without prior authorization from ANH.

To this end, ANH has prepared activities, tools, and information, along with appropriate support, for Data Room sessions, scheduled as per the Calendar.

Review and assessment of technical information can be conducted in person in Bogotá or via self-guided virtual sessions, based on each company's specific interest, starting from the day of the final Bidding Documents and Conditions release until the last business day before bid submission.

1. In-Person Sessions

In these sessions, attendees can view presentations of available information and address their inquiries, including technical and socio-environmental data. Sessions will be conducted by:

- a. DIMAR
- b. Ministry of Mines and Energy, through professionals from the Office of Regulatory and Business Affairs.
- c. ANH, including geologists from the Technical Vice Presidency and the Communities and Environment team of the Hydrocarbons Contracts Vice Presidency, among others.

Other relevant entities may also be invited to provide additional process information.

These sessions will take place at ANH facilities on business days, at Avenida Calle 26 No. 59 - 65, 2nd Floor, Colombian Infrastructure Chamber Building. They will last up to four (4) hours, either from 08:00 AM to 12:00 PM or from 01:00 PM to 05:00 PM, Colombian time (GMT-5).

Requests for extended time should be specified in the application and are subject to ANH availability.

2. Self-Guided Virtual Sessions

To facilitate access from any computer or mobile device to ANH's technological platform, the users indicated by the legal entity interested in visualizing the technical and socio-environmental information will be activated for up to twenty-four (24) continuous Hours starting from the session's commencement, which can be extended by the ANH.

3. General Rules

- a) Requests for additional time beyond the standard allotment should be specified in the application. Approval of such requests is contingent on ANH availability.
- b) The number of sessions per interested party will be determined based on the available time to ensure equal opportunity for all.
- c) To schedule sessions for the Data Room, the authorized representative of the interested legal entity must submit a request to the National Agency of Hydrocarbons (ANH) via email at rondaeolicacostaafuera@anh.gov.co, providing the following details:
 - Business name or corporate title of the requesting legal entity.
 - Primary company's object.
 - Principal address (city and country).
 - Record of experience in projects related to Non-Conventional Renewable Energy Sources.
 - Address, phone numbers, and email.
 - Name and identification of the authorized representative submitting the request.
 - Tax Identification Number (NIT), if the entity is taxable in Colombia.
 - Desired session type: (I) In-person in Bogotá, or (II) Virtual.
 - Full name and identification of the potential Data Room service users.
 - Preferred date(s) for the session.
 - Number of sessions desired by the legal entity.

Upon verification of the information, ANH will schedule the session, notifying via email at least two (2) business days in advance with the assigned date(s) and time(s). ANH allows a maximum of two Data Room sessions daily.

4. Download of data for analysis purposes

In order to allow access to the data from any computer or mobile device, one (1) user account will be provided per legal entity interested in downloading the

technical and socio-environmental information. ANH will inform interested parties of the procedure and technological requirements to complete the download.
