



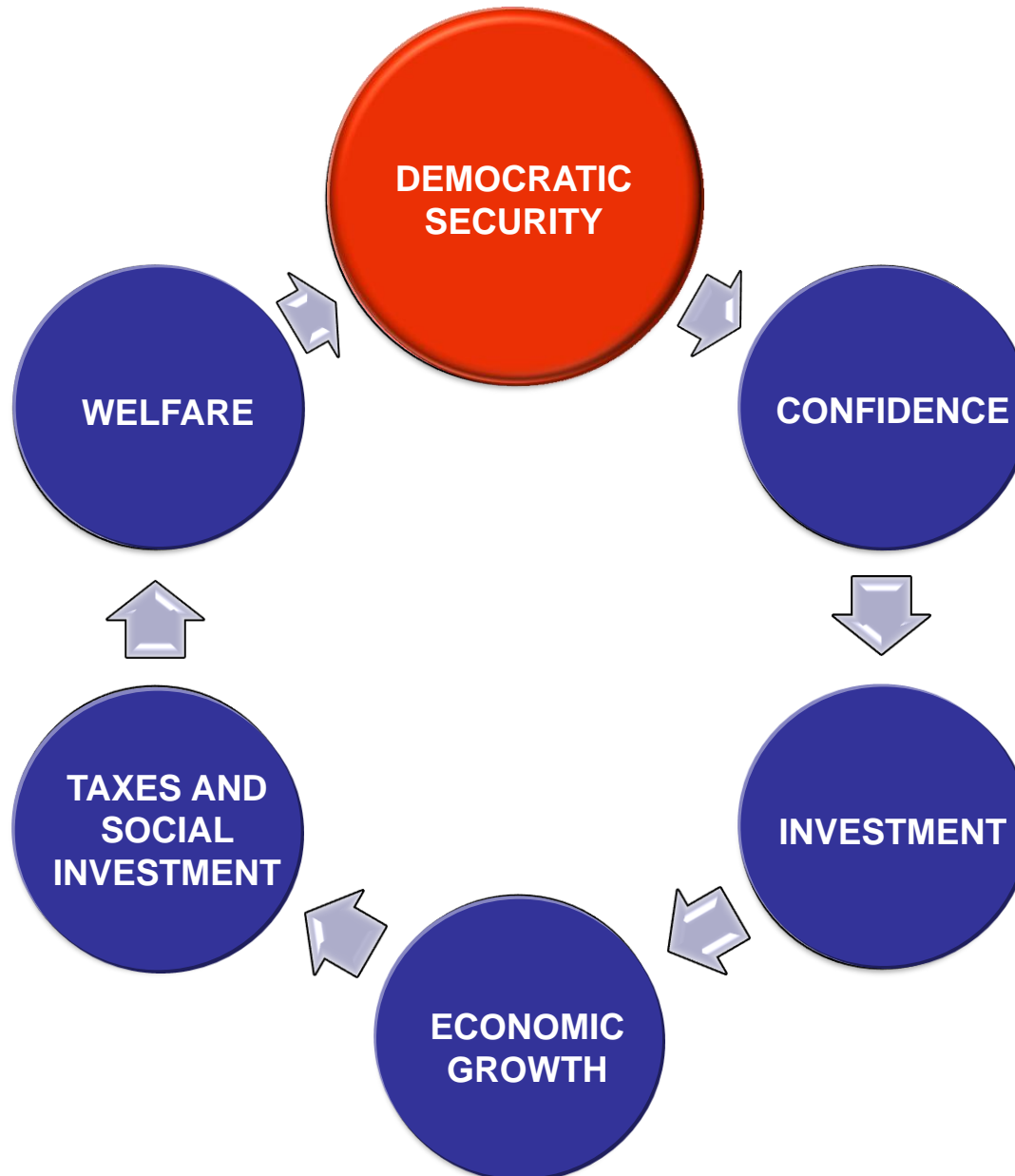

Consolidation of the Democratic Security Policy

*“Promoting **security** as a condition for **economic** growth and **social** profitability. The operations of the security forces should continue to contribute to a climate of confidence and stability that will support private investment and generate economic growth and social development through the reduction of unemployment and poverty. Greater security should create the conditions for the due presence of State social services for the benefit of the people in most need.”*



DEMOCRATIC SECURITY POLICY (DSP) STRATEGIES

- 1. DSP Consolidation:** Territorial control and defense of national sovereignty, combat of drug traffic and organized crime and promotion of a policy of safety and peaceful coexistence.
- 2. Displacement, Human Rights and Reconciliation:** To prevent and mitigate the effects originated in the violation of human rights by “NTOs*” (forced displacement, attacks to villages, the use of anti-person mines, etc.)

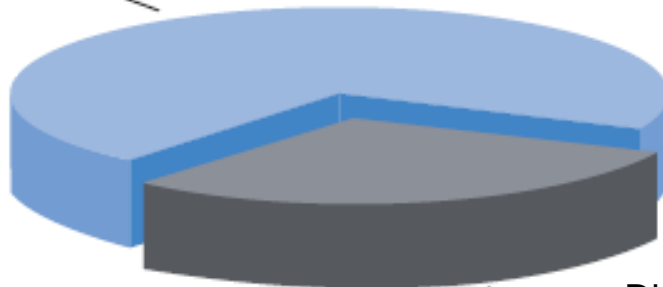

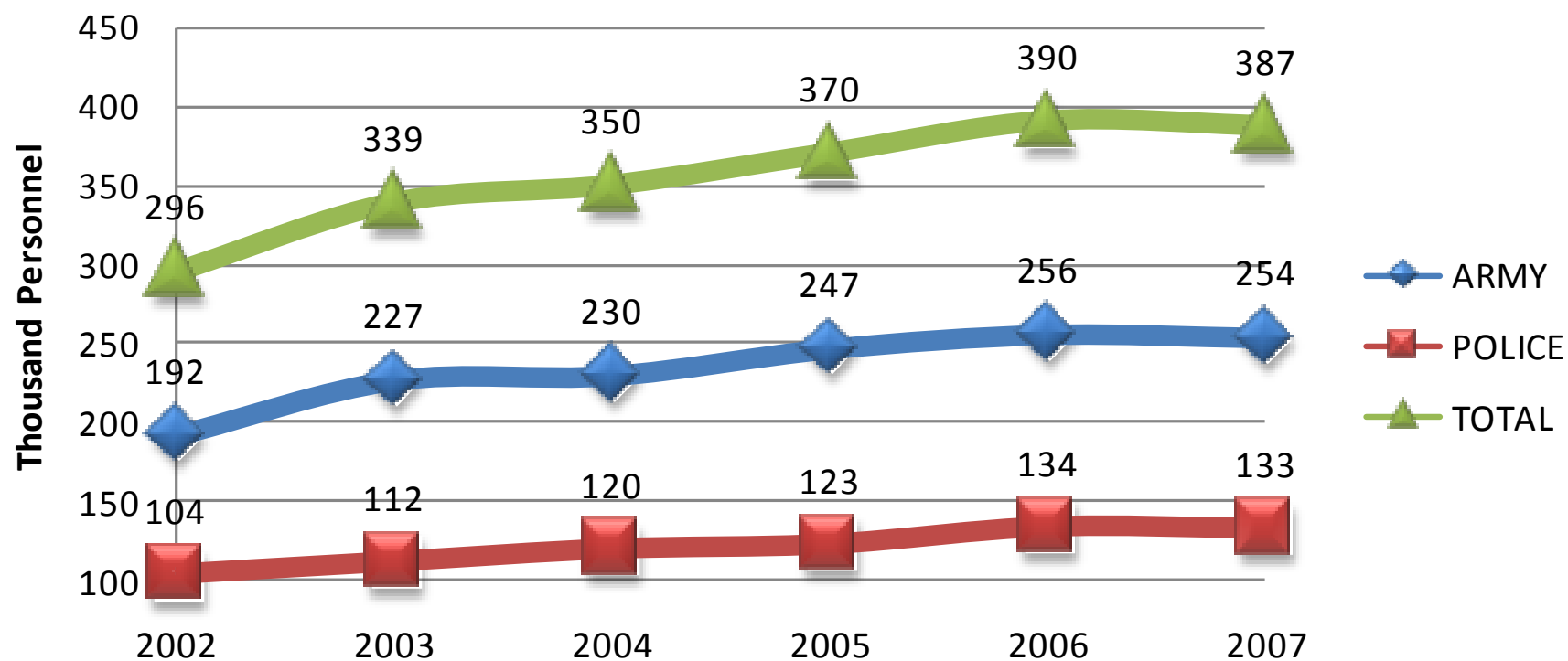

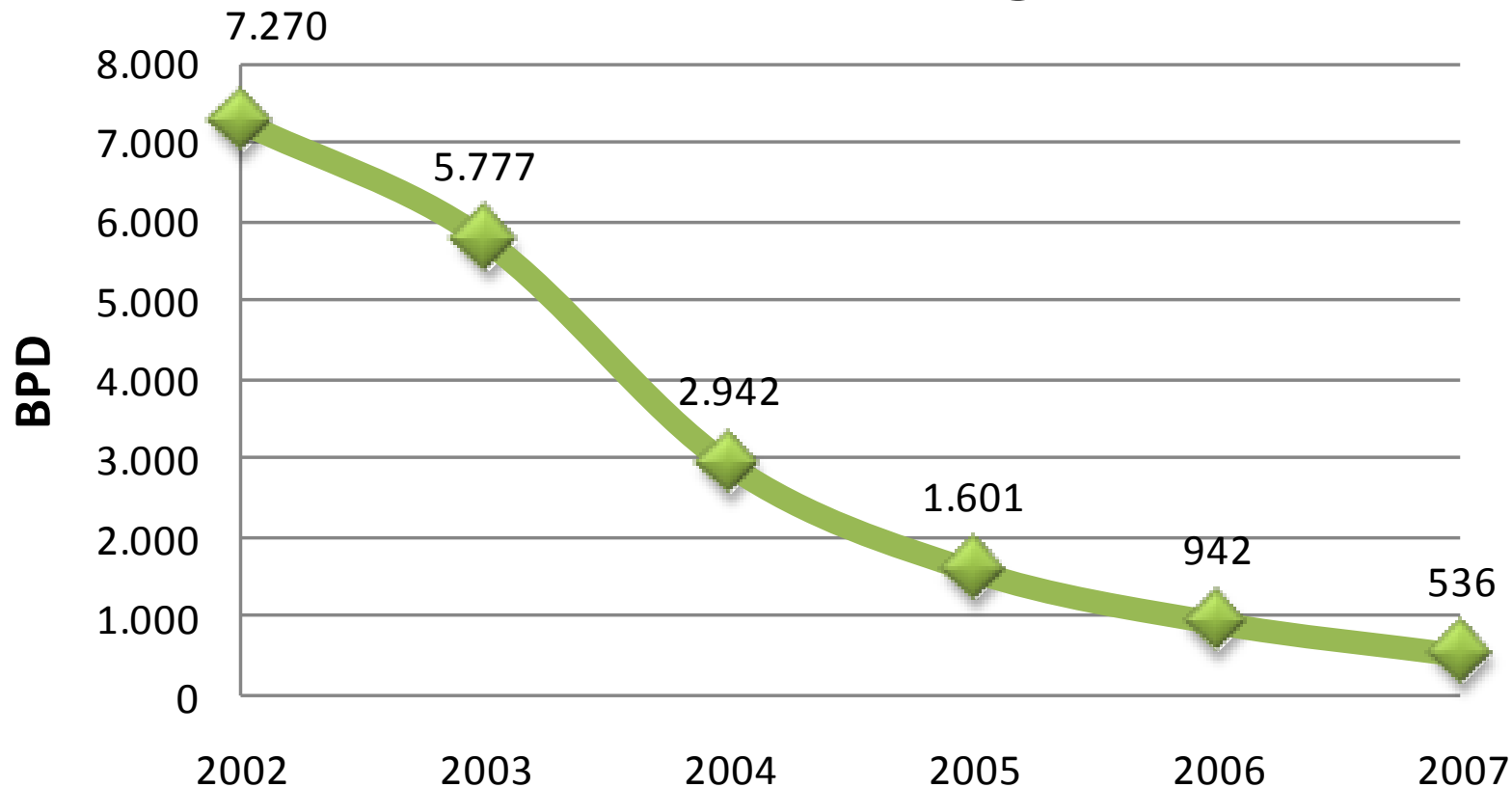

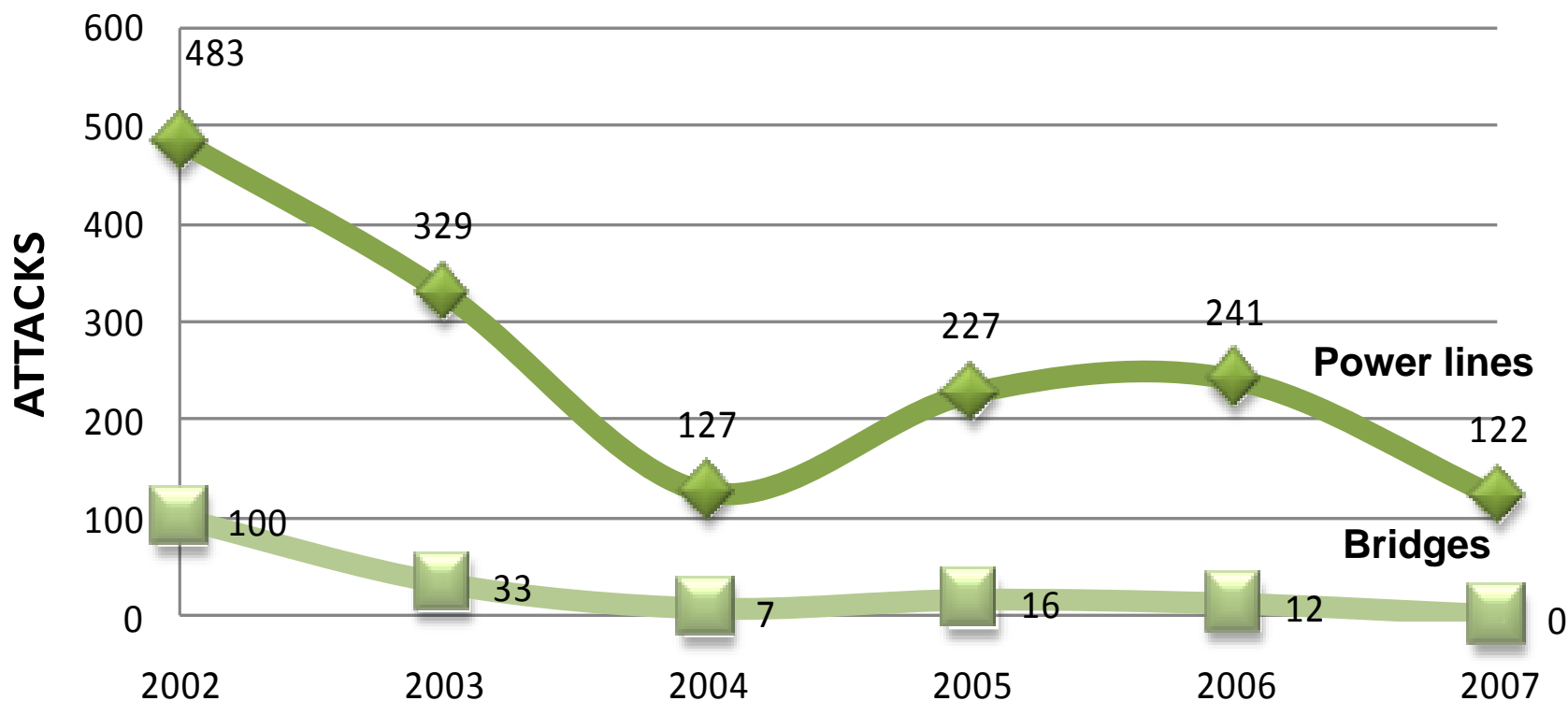

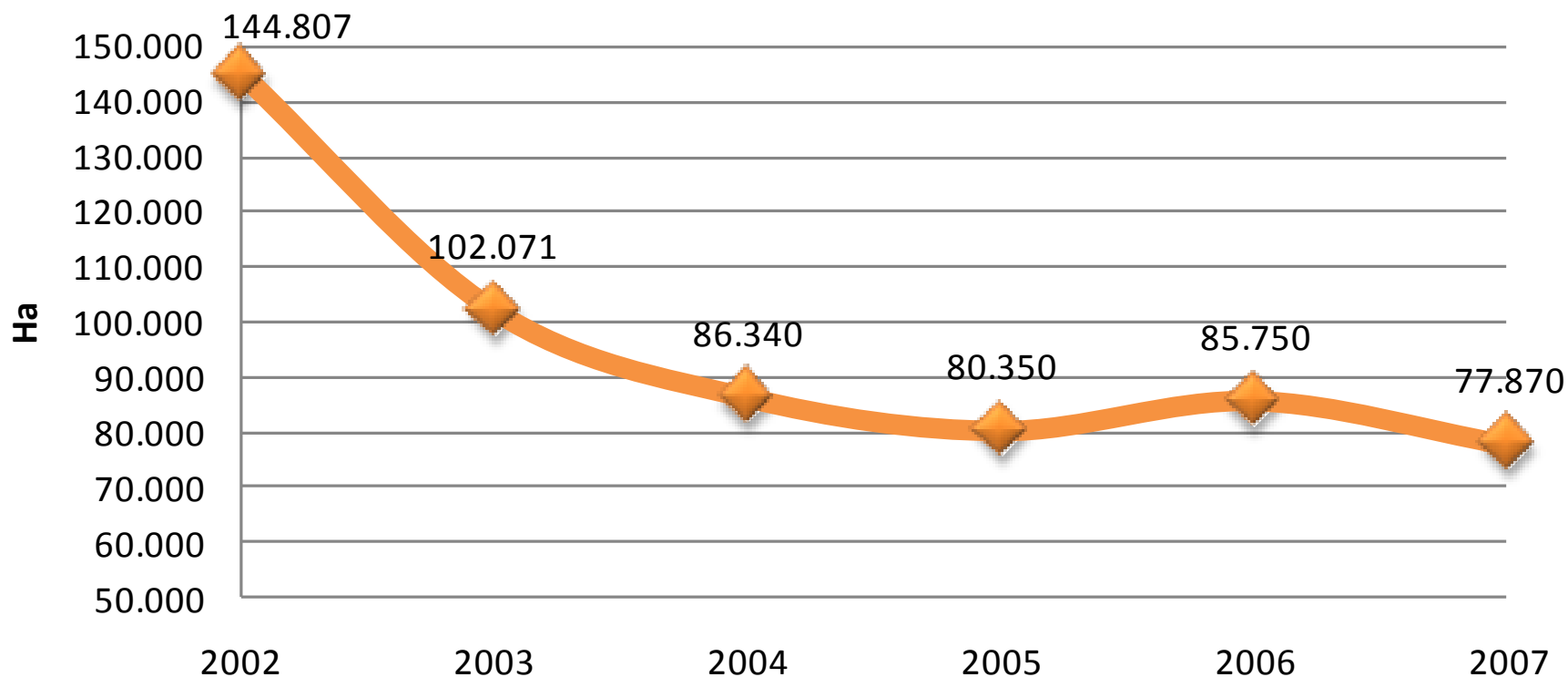


Terrorist Attack to Bridges and Power Lines



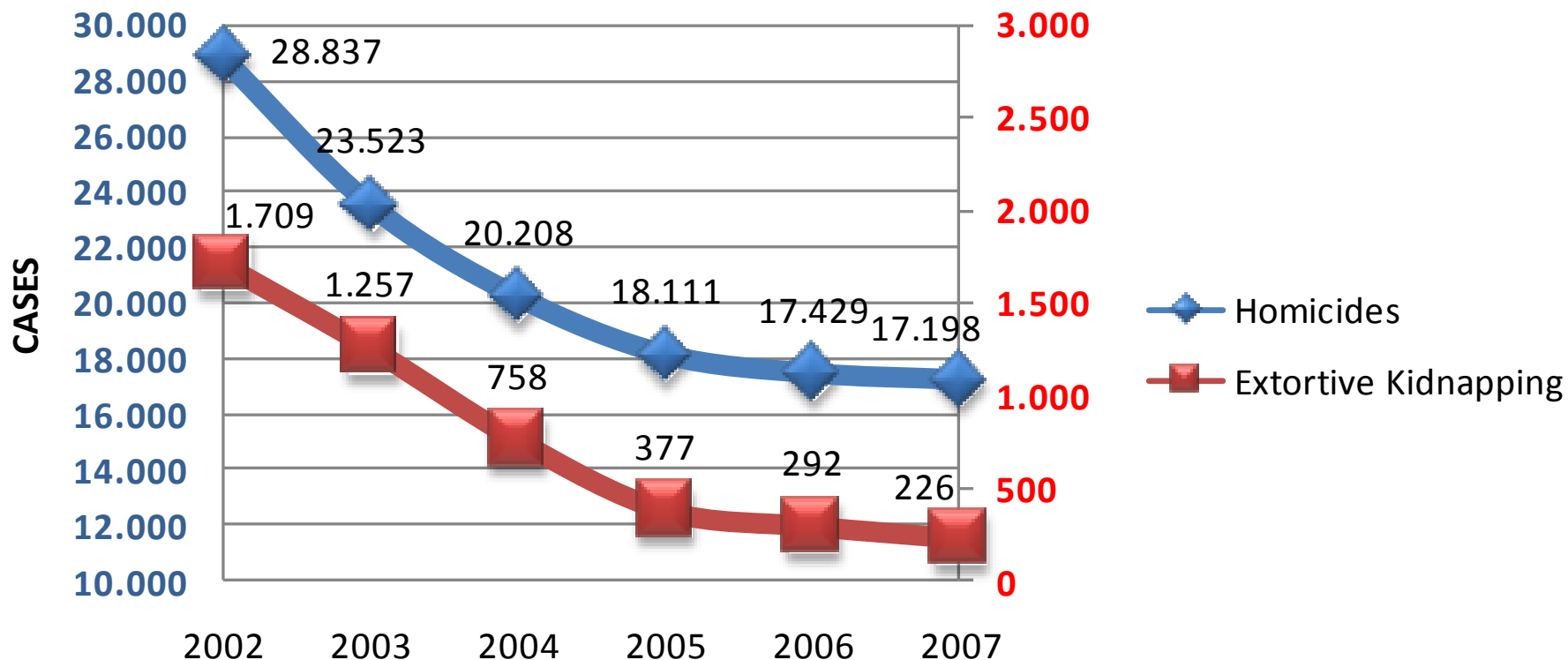


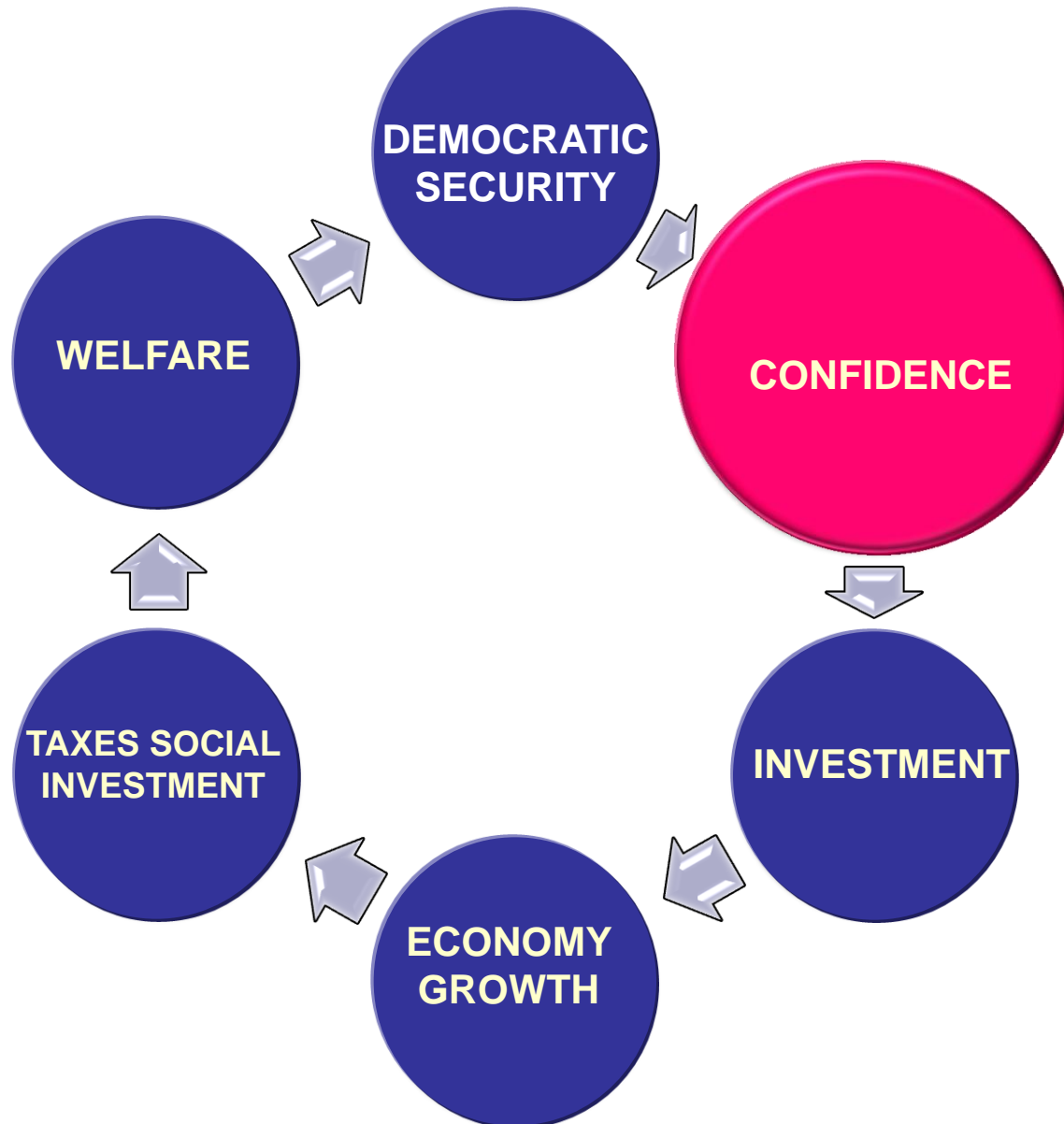
Surface with illegal crops (Ha)



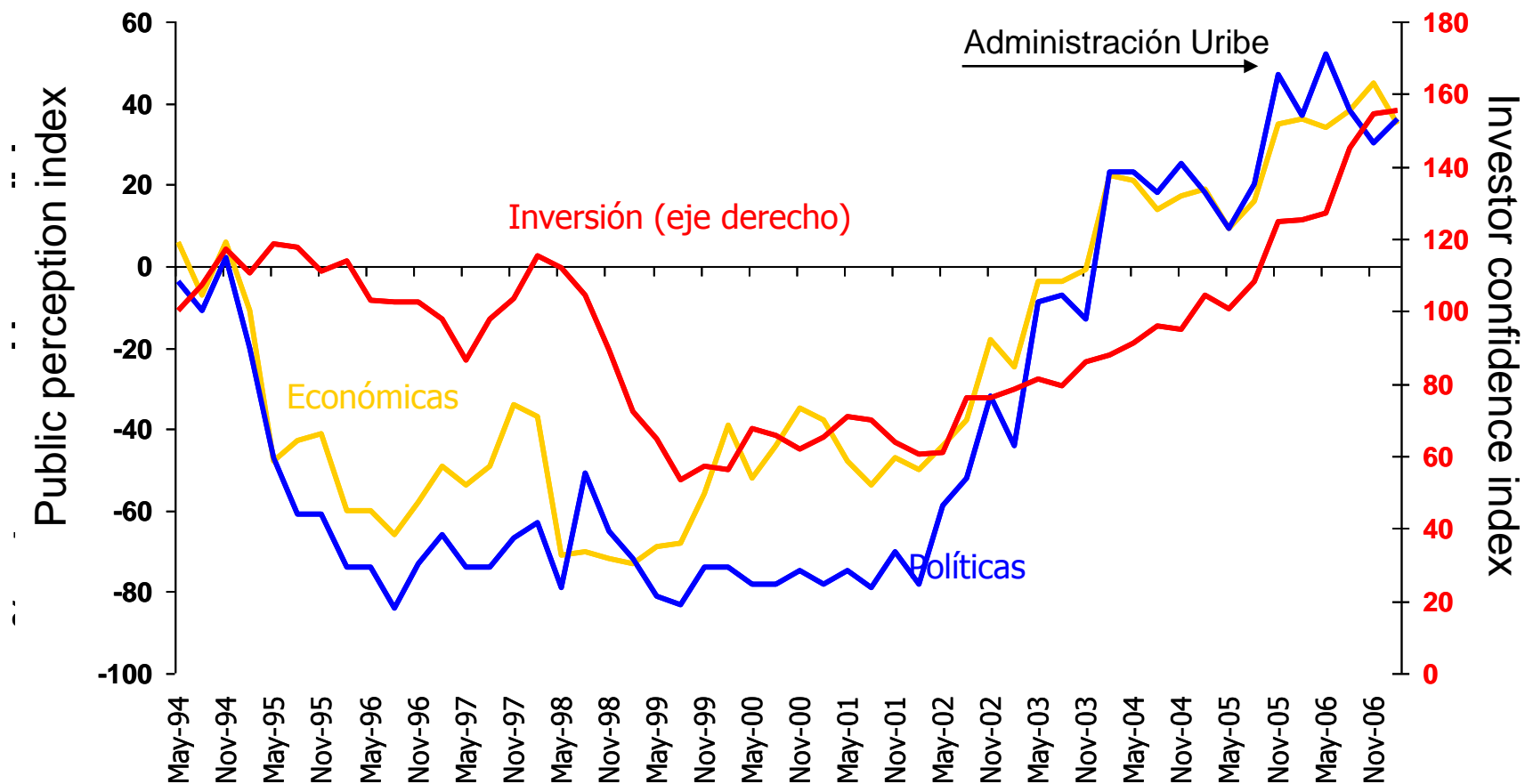


Homicides And Extortive Kidnapping

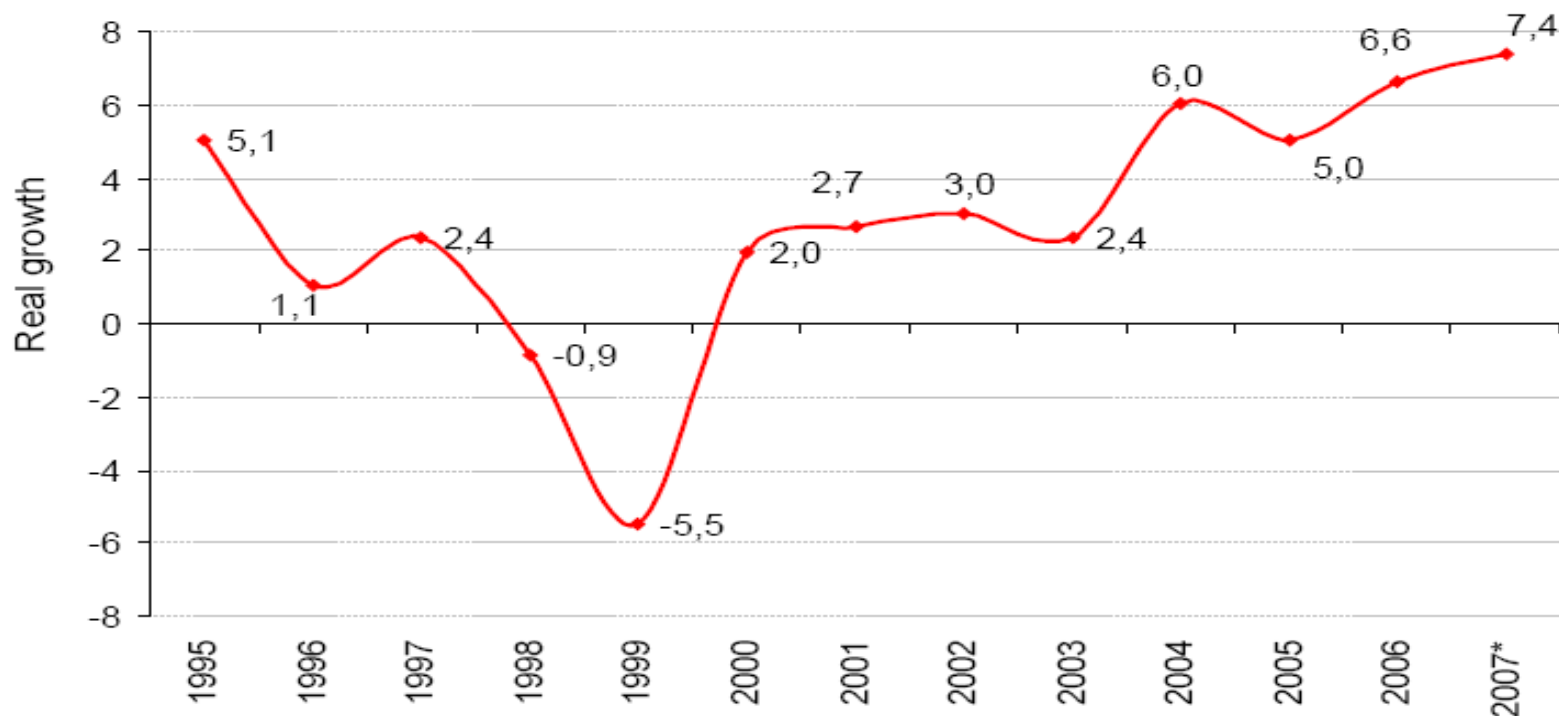

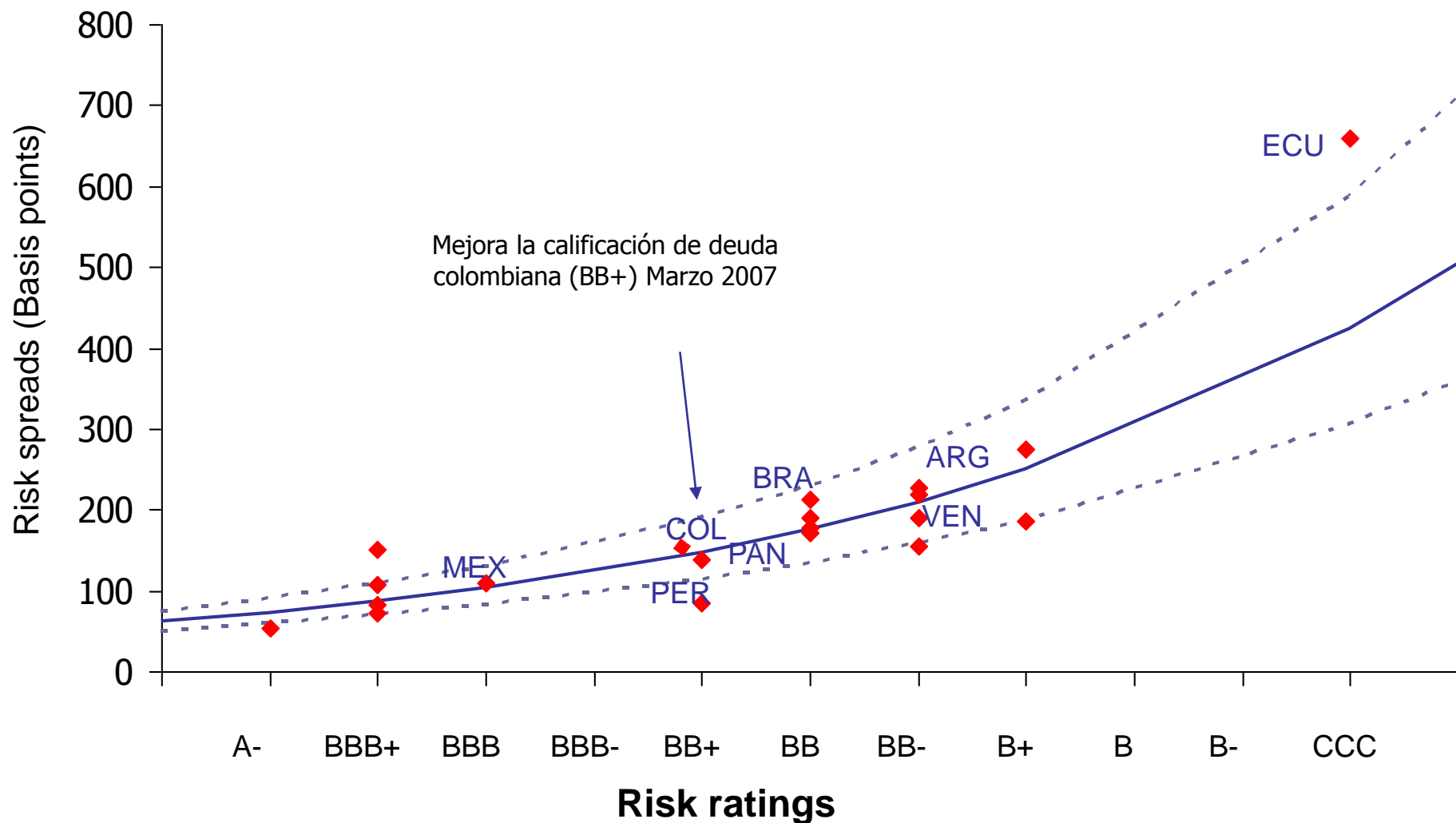

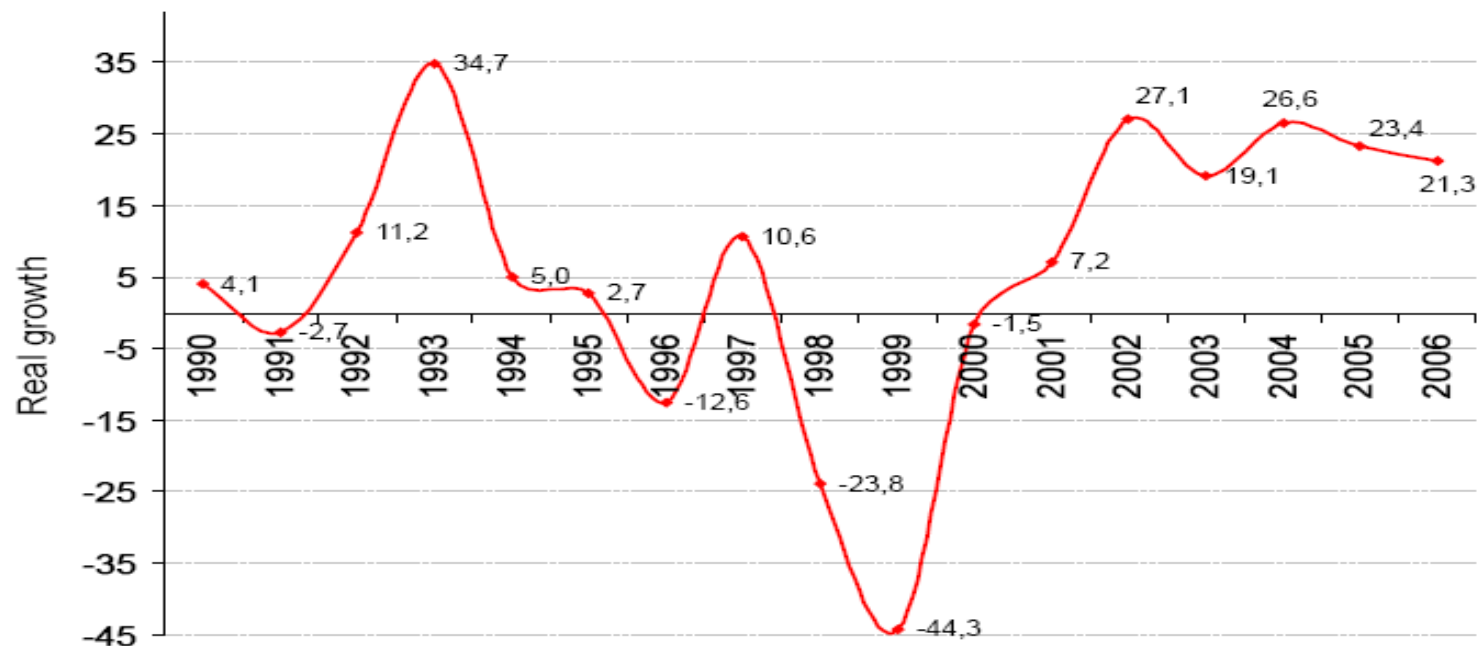

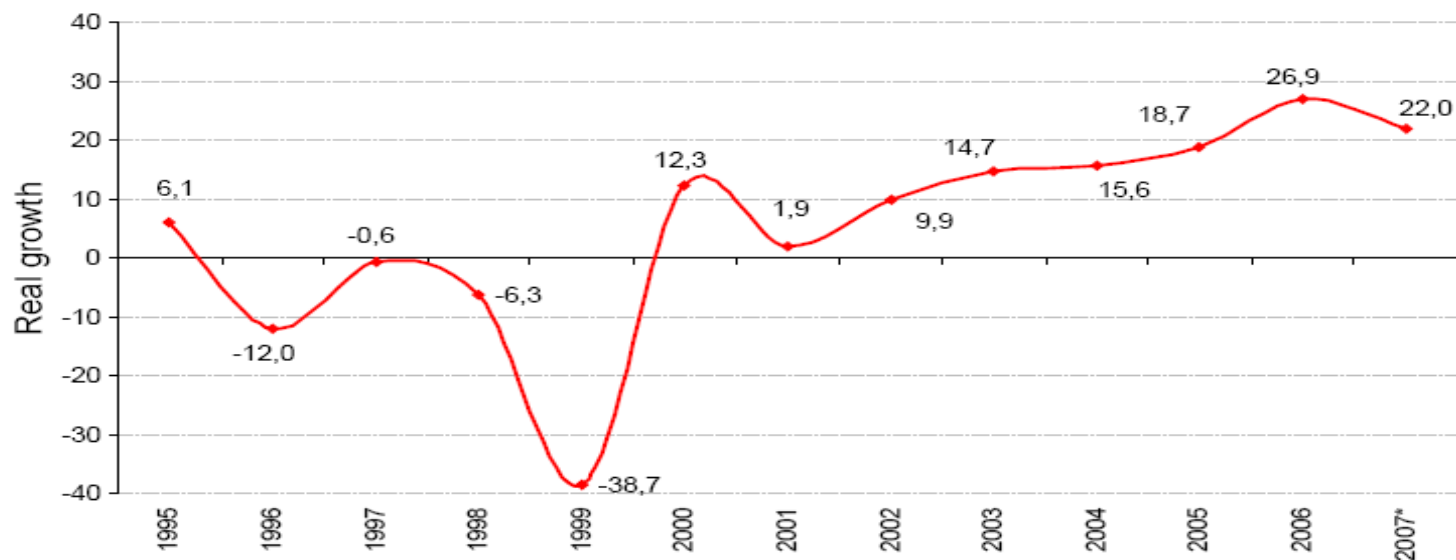

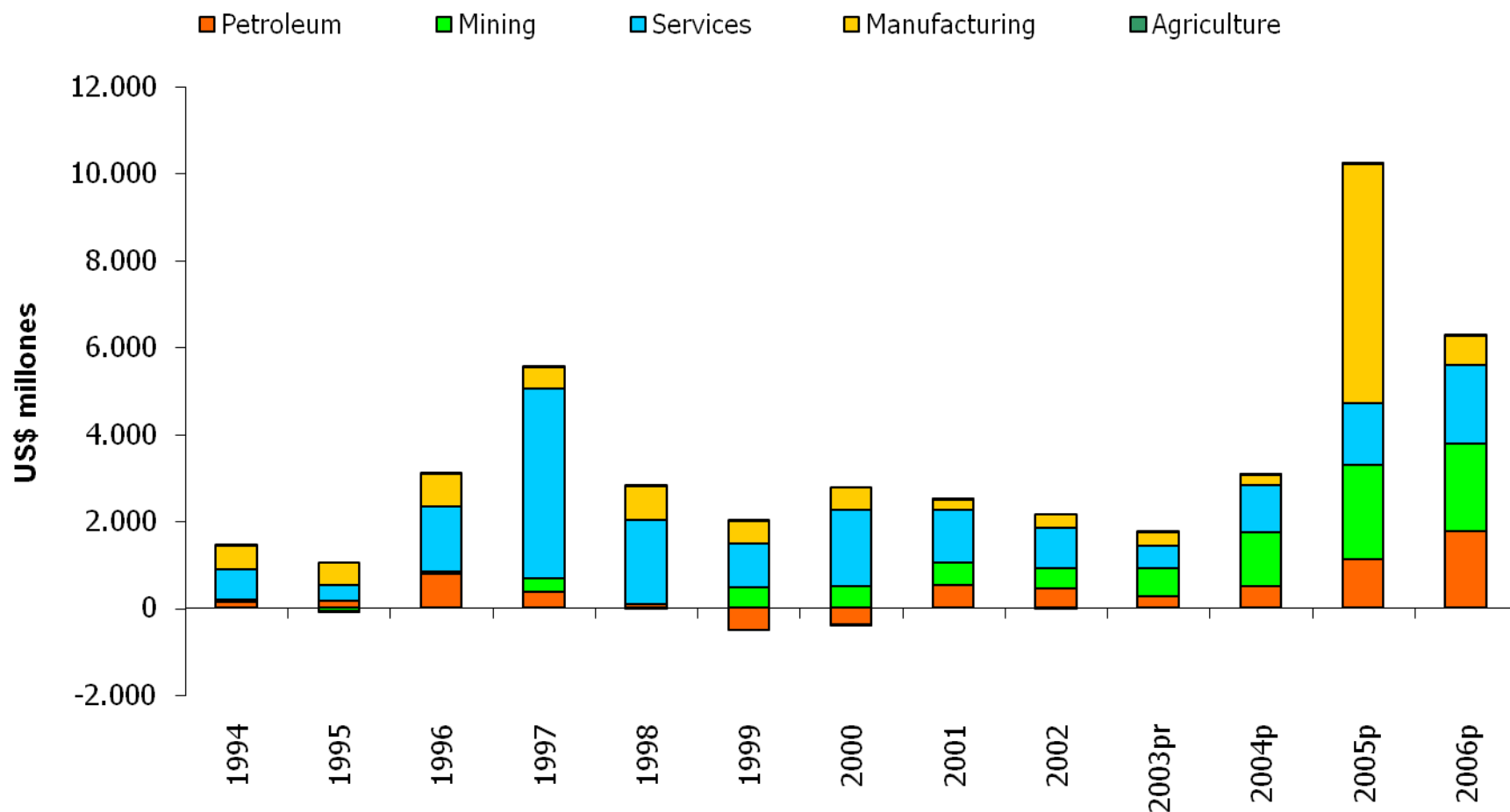

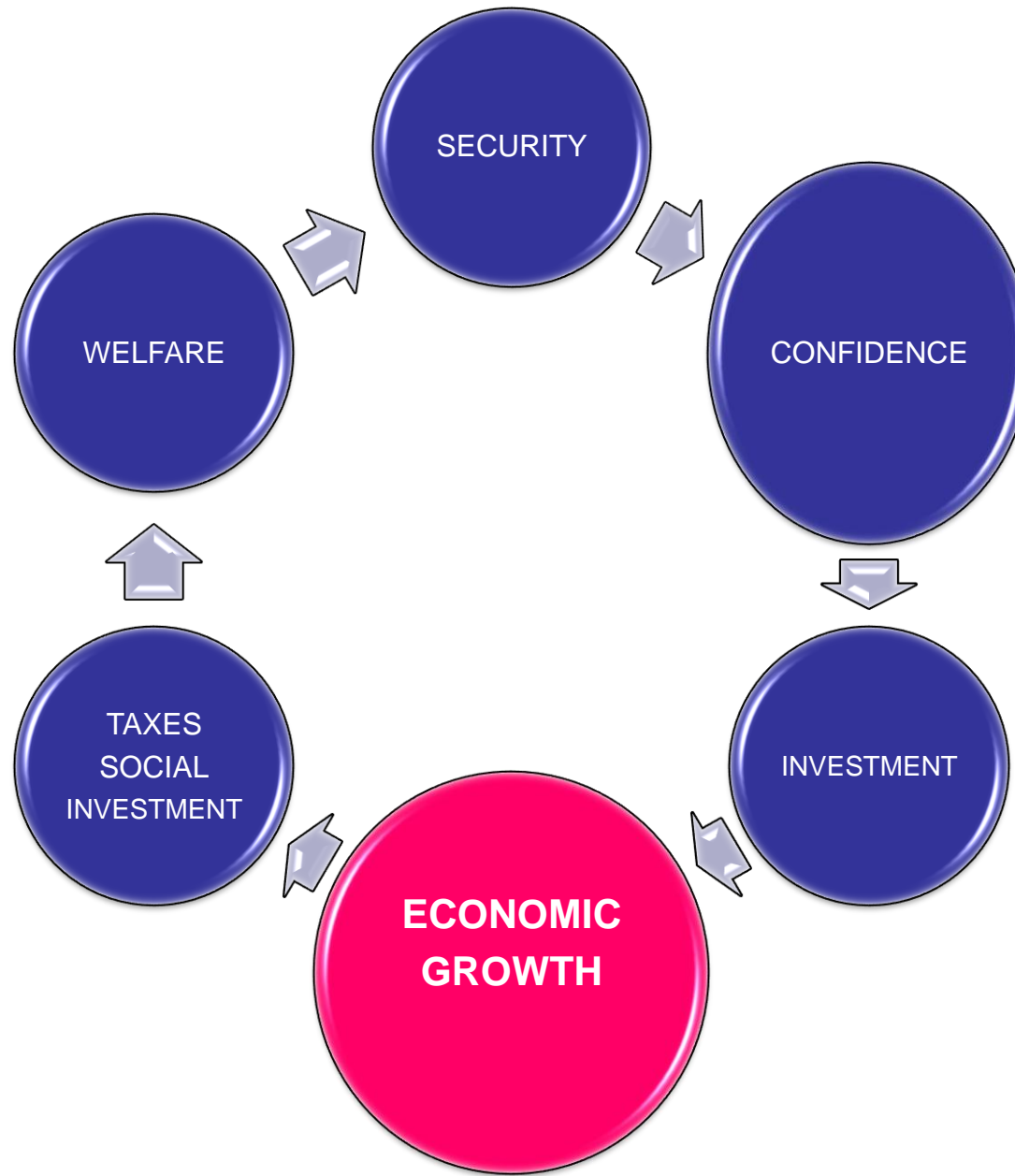

US\$ millones, 1994-2006

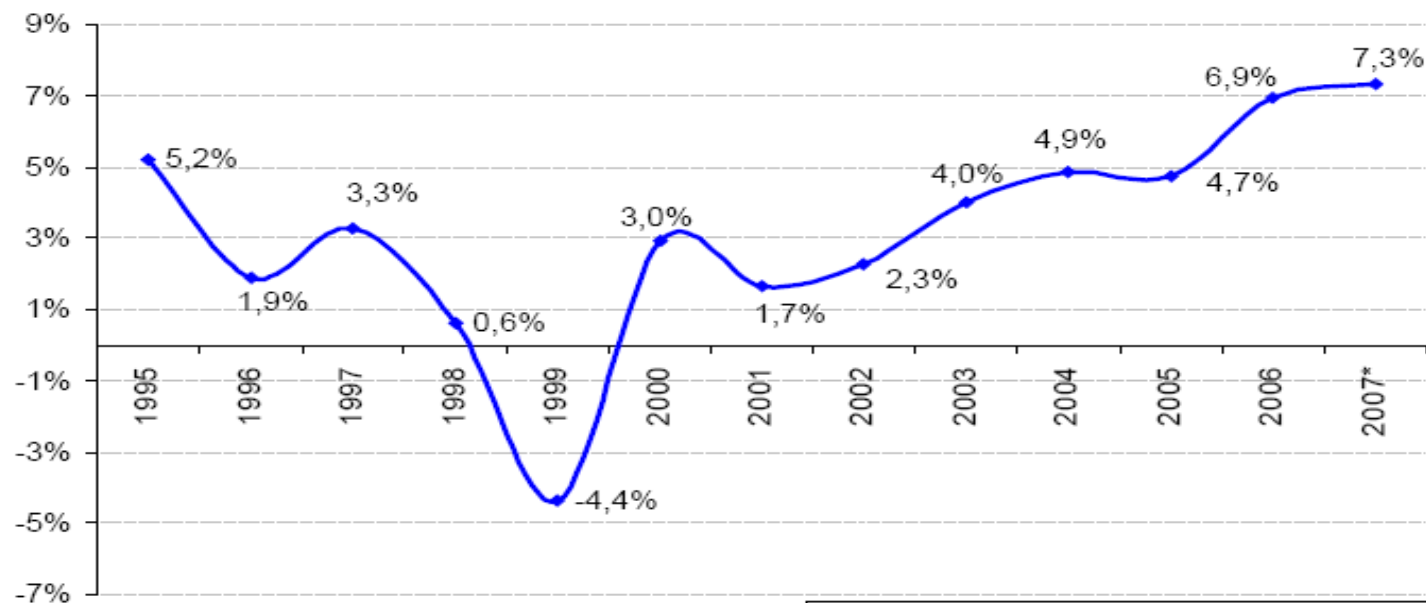

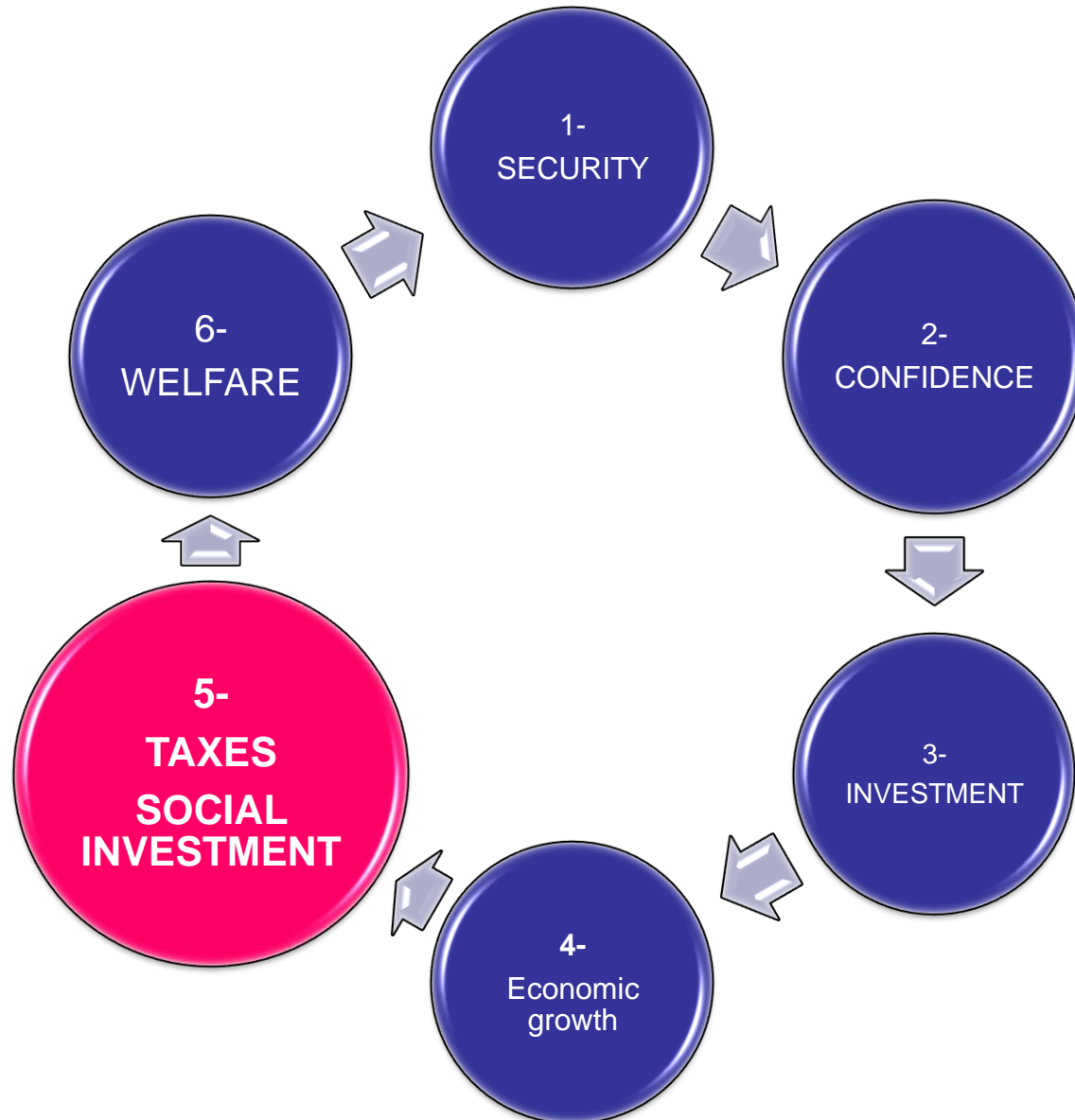

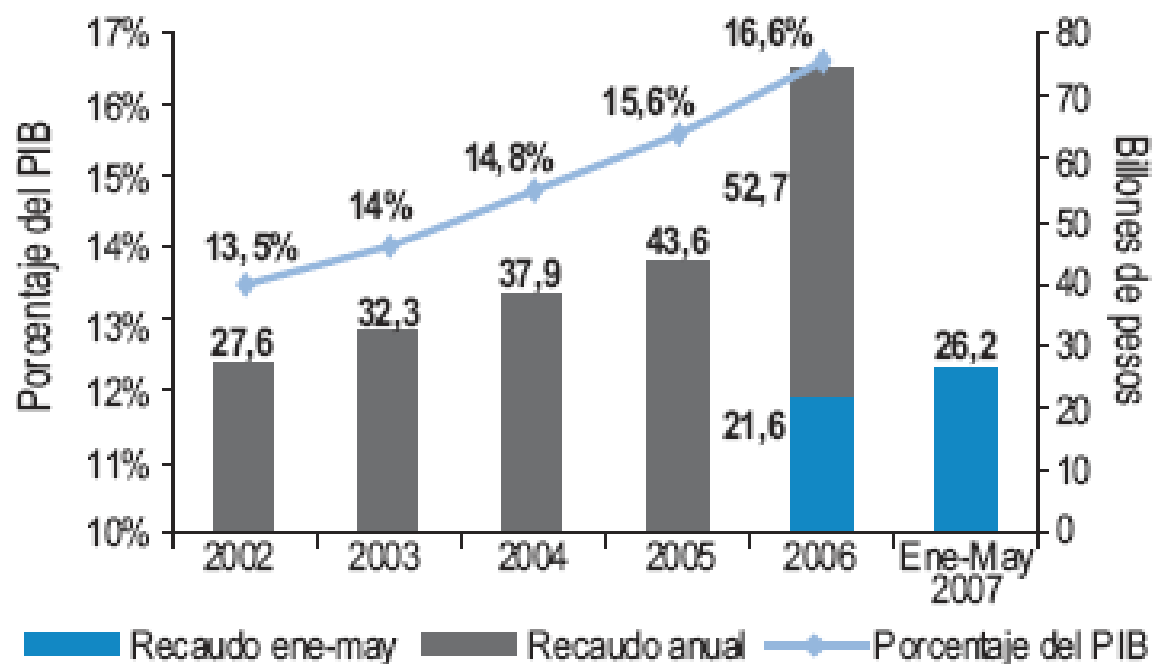

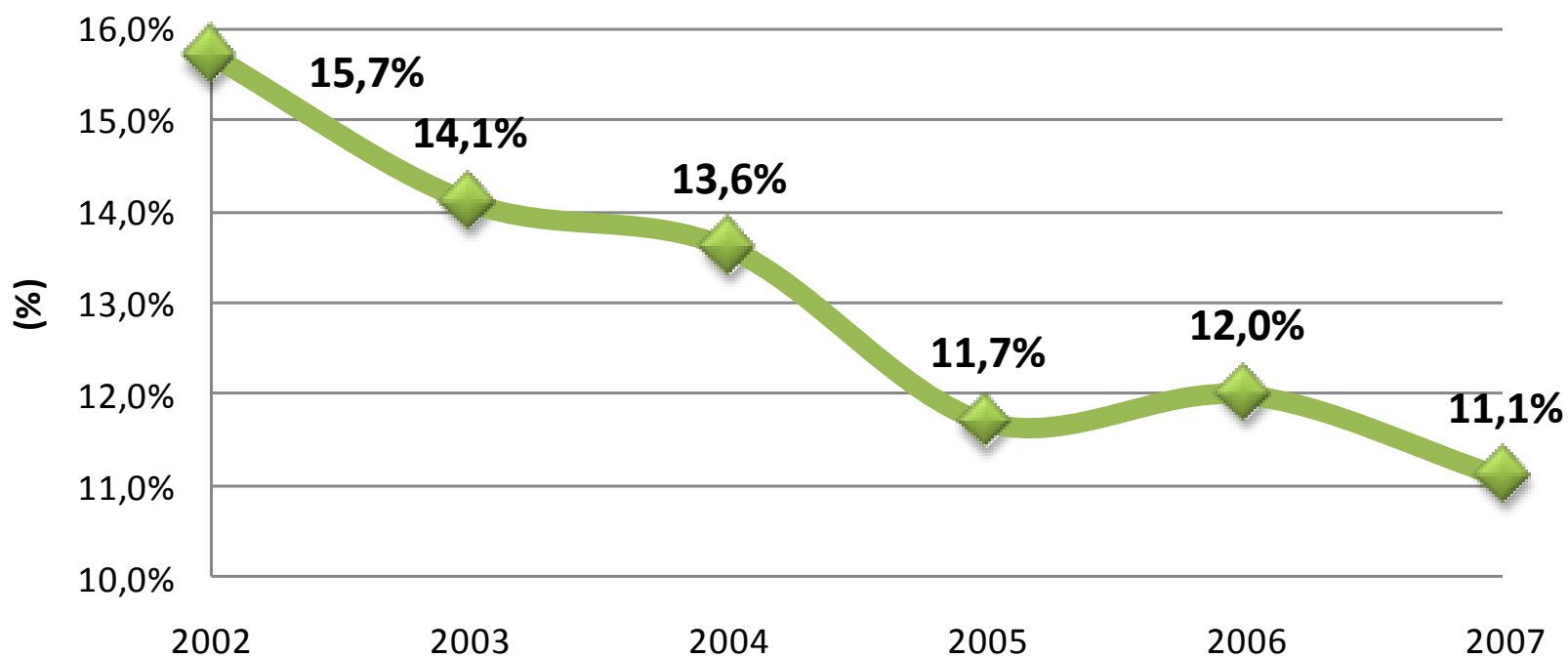
Tax collection rate (percent of GDP)

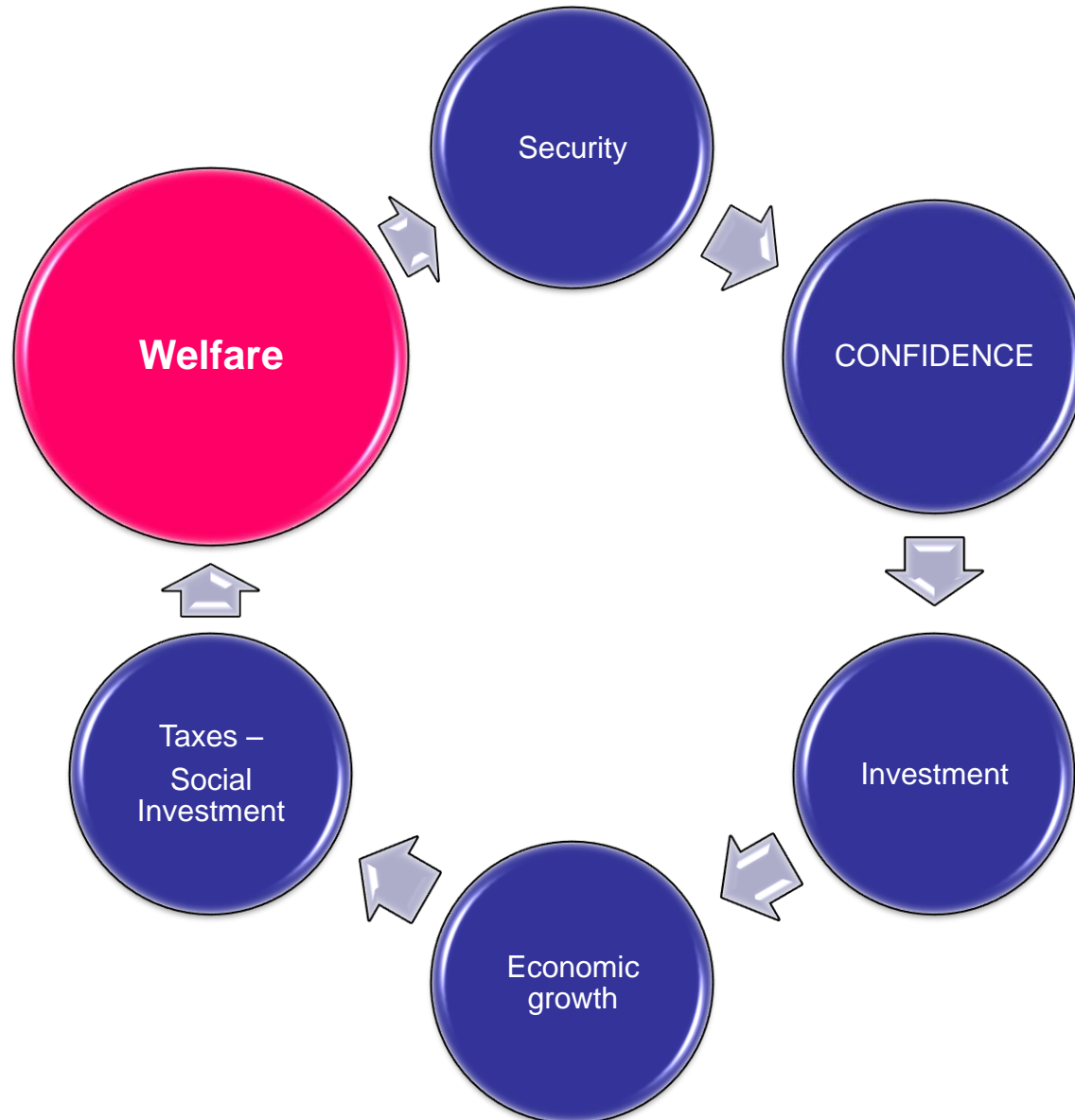

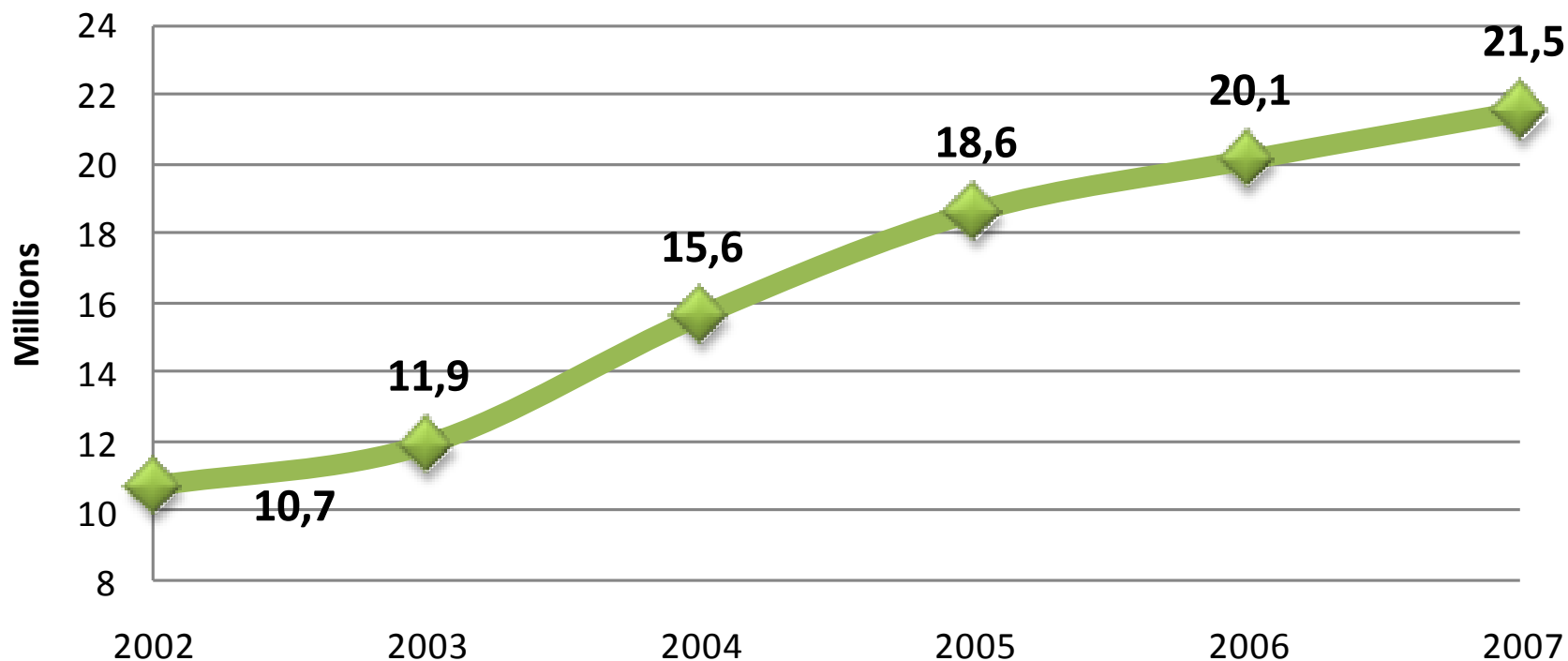
Unemployment





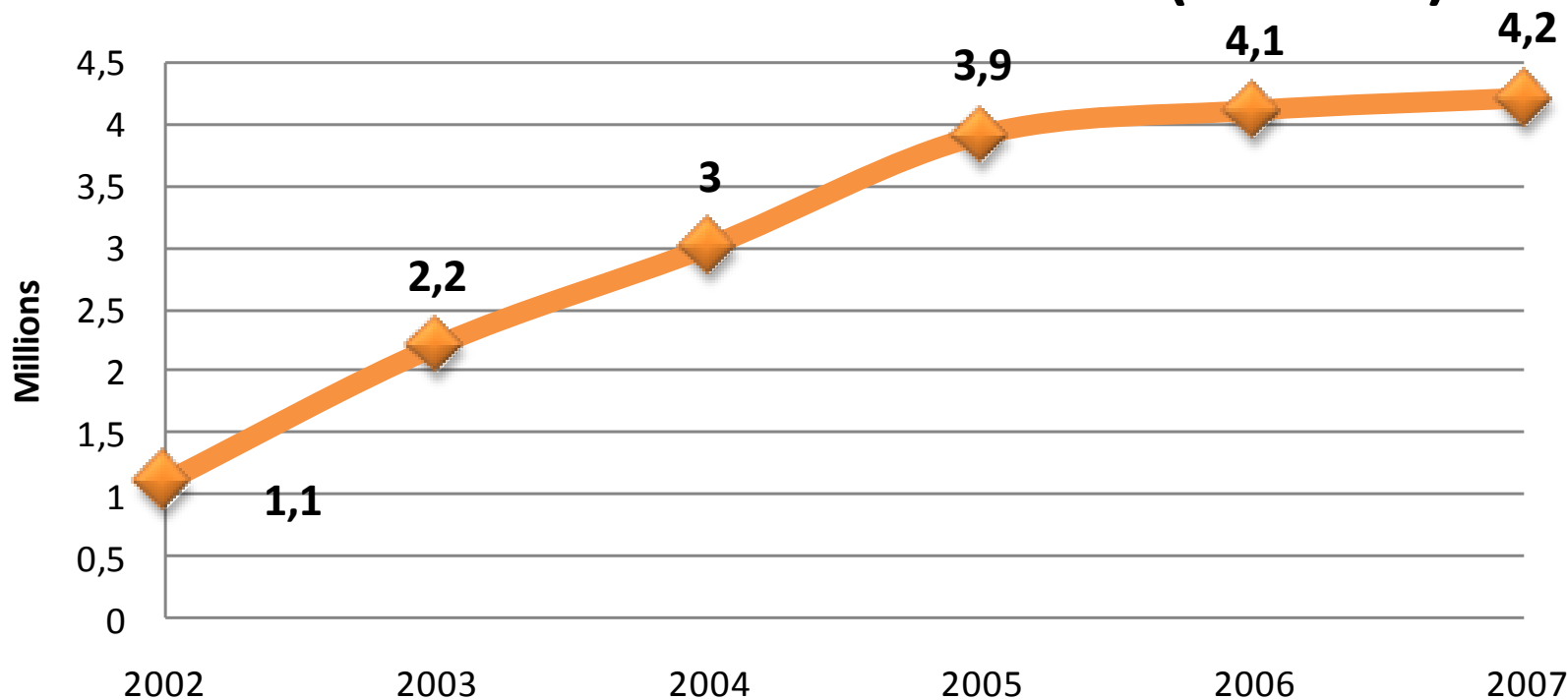


Public Health Care (millions)



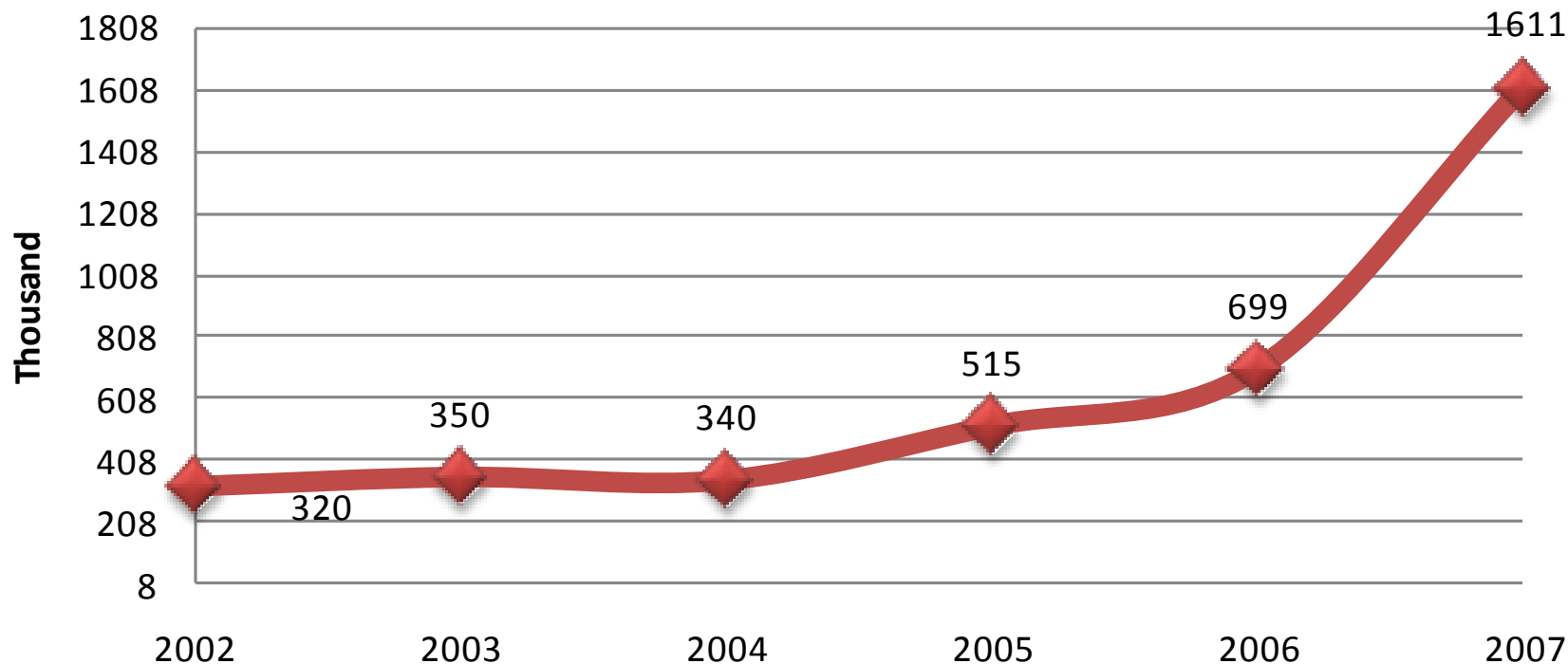


Profesional Formation - SENA (millions)
